

What is Button Up WEC all about?

Button Up Button Up WEC is a member service to improve your home's energy performance and save money while reducing fossil fuel emissions. In 2017, and in future years WEC and other Vermont electric utilities have a statutory requirement under ACT 56 / Renewable Energy Standard to reduce the greenhouse gas emissions of their customers.

The Coop Board of Directors has approved WEC's "Button Up WEC" program, and members are encouraged to understand what this service includes. Working with Efficiency Vermont, Capstone Community Action, ReSource and our other partners, WEC members who participate in 2017 will be eligible for incentives to improve the energy performance of their residences.

WEC's primary role in Button Up WEC is to inform members whose homes meet minimum energy performance standards, and to advise on energy upgrade options that improve comfort, lower operating cost, and enhance the equity value of their property. WEC will be offering incentives that
