

Dear WEC Members, as you may be aware; violent storms this summer have caused numerous outages on the electric utility lines that serve your area. WEC crews are in the process of patrolling all of the lines in the **Moretown-Middlesex and Duxbury area** in an effort to identify and then eliminate potential causes of additional outages. Please note that we will be working with land owners and removing multiple large trees located outside of the utility corridor over the next few weeks to help prevent additional outages. Crews have identified several cracked or broken poles and have replaced them with new poles.

A scheduled outage will occur Monday, August 21, from 1:00pm to 2:30 for 90 minutes to allow crews to move the wires onto the new poles. We apologize for the inconvenience and want you to know we are taking appropriate steps to improve the resiliency of the lines that serve your homes. **If you are aware of any trees that are leaning toward our lines or poles that have been washed out by the ongoing rains please contact us immediately. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the planned outage please contact us as well. We greatly appreciate your patience and assistance as we work to reduce outages in your area.**
