

NOTICE TO WASHINGTON ELECTRIC CO-OP MEMBERS

Notice of Proposed Tariff Change March 19, 2019

On March 19, 2019, Washington Electric Cooperative, Inc. filed: (1) its General Terms and Conditions Tariff (GTC Tariff) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (PUC), and (2) a proposed change to its Net Metering Tariff. The GTC Tariff is a compilation of all of WEC's existing tariffs. The proposed change to the Net Metering Tariff is reflected in the GTC Tariff:

Effective May 6, 2019, the tariff for purchase and installation of a second meter for net metering installations will increase from the current charge of \$222.56 to \$243.70.

This change will take effect in 45 days, or on May 6, 2019.

The updated charge for the second meter is on page 10 of the Net Metering Tariff, or on page 55 of the GTC Tariff.
