## State of Vermont Incentives

The State of Vermont has launched a new incentive program to get more plug-in electric vehicles (EVs) on the road.

The Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTTrans) is overseeing this program, which was authorized by the Vermont Legislature to grant \$1,100,000 in electric car incentives to Vermont residents. Interested Vermonters are encouraged to act quickly to take advantage of this program while funds are available.

Incentive amounts vary by household income level and whether the vehicle is an all-electric or plug-in hybrid. State incentive funds will be equally available to all Vermonters on a

first-come, first-served basis.

### Are you eligible?

The program incentives will be available to Vermont residents only - a current Vermont driver's license is required as proof of residency.

Incentive eligibility is limited to household incomes at or below 160 percent of the State's prior five-year average median household income. See the table for details.

Incentives for lower income households qualifying for the State's home weatherization program will be eligible for a higher incentive.

There is a limit of one incentive per household.

The incentive program does not extend to commercial or non-profit organizations. This program does not apply retroactively to purchases made before the program launch on December 16, 2019.

For personal use vehicles only; not available for vehicles intended for resale.

Incentives are available for plug-in electric vehicles sold/leased as new with a base manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) of \$40,000 or less.

Leases must be for a term of 24 months or longer.
